

Conducting a semi-structured interview
Lesson 2: The heart of the interview

Instructions - Exercise 3

LEARNING OBJECTIVE

- Adapt one's attitude to the context,
- Maintain one's bearing as an interviewer (and not as a technician).

PROCEDURE STEP-BY-STEP

- 1) Before starting the exercise, consult the file entitled, "Presentation of the Larzac case", which presents the context (in the annex).
- 2) Working with short video extracts from various interviews conducted in Larzac (sheep farming region, France):
 - a. respond to the question that appears at the end of each video extract. At the end of each extract, you will be given some time to think; the last 5 seconds of this period is counted by a timer. You also may put the video on pause while noting down your response. The correct response then will appear.
